For the purpose of this award, an elementary physical educator is defined as an individual who has major responsibility for teaching physical education in grades K through 6 for a specific school or school system and is a member of OAHPERD/NASPE/AAHPERD.

- Has a minimum of six (6) years teaching experience as an elementary school physical education teacher.
- Serves as a positive role model epitomizing personal health and fitness, enjoyment of activity, sportspersonship, and sensitivity to the needs of students.
- Utilizes various teaching methodologies and plans innovative learning experiences.
- Conducts a balanced and sequential curriculum.
- Assumes responsibility for his/her professional growth.
- Evidences professional commitment through membership and involvement in local state, and national physical education organizations.
- Has made significant contributions to the field of physical education.

#### Criteria

The nominee should address each of the following criteria using not more than one page double spaced for each criterion. Also, include two letters of recommendation based on the criteria. One letter should be from a peer teacher and the other from someone in an administrative capacity who is familiar with the candidate's teaching skills. Selection will be based on how the State Selection Committee feels the candidate meets the criteria. If the candidate is the state winner, additional information will be needed for continuing on to Midwest and National.
